To indicate the commencement of the two minute silence, a siren will be blown from 10.59 a.m. to 11.00 a.m. The siren will be blown again from 11.02 a.m. to 11.03 a.m. to indicate the end of the silence.

2. The Martyr's Day shall be observed with full solemnity and in a befitting manner by conducting Speeches and talks connected with the significance of the day, particularly mentioning the role of freedom fighters in the Freedom Struggle. The theme of talks and speeches could also deal with the duty and the moral obligation of every citizen to preserve, protect and enrich the hard earned freedom and to promote a sense of national integration and commitment to common goals and ideals. 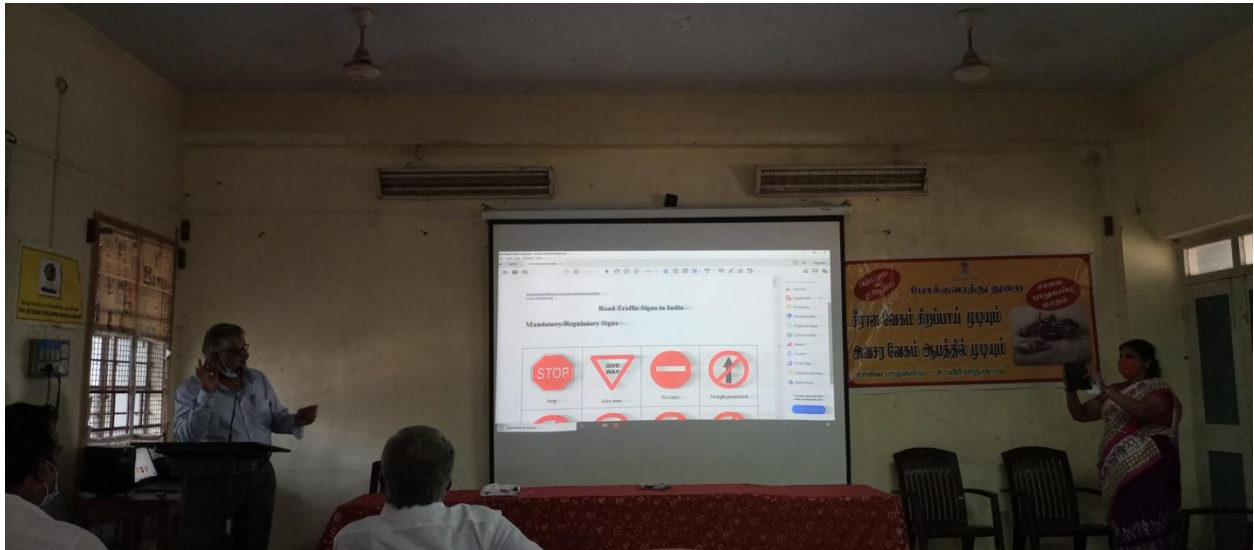

Perunthalaivar Kamarajar Arts College envisions a life oriented education that empowers students to respond proactively to social concerns by promoting programmes. Jayakumar, Commissioner, Mannadipet Commune Panchayat, Puducherry delivered the special address. The inaugural speech was delivered by Principal Dr. S. Babu who emphasized the role of NSS in the community service. He pointed out that "In society all the human beings have comprises equal importance, irrespective of the gender." He also said that the dedication towards community is must to accomplish the goals and dreams in life. Our beloved Principal Dr. S. Babu have also addressed the volunteers and passed a message of to be kind & to be helpful to the needy people. Programme was conducted by NSS Programme officers of the Units Mr. Z. Nihmathullah and

Dr. A. Perumal Assistant Professors of the college who have also expressed their opinions about the NSS Camp. Volunteers cleaned the college road, removed dust heaps and attempted to create awareness on cleanliness and hygiene. They swept with brooms inside the college premises.







DAY - 2: 23-02-2021 (TUESDAY)

Tree Plantation programme was organized and successfully completed at college campus. Trees are the foremost source for the production of the oxygen in environment, they help to reduce the level of CO₂. As we all know that the whole world is facing the problem of global warming and to overcome such problem, planting the trees become one of the most important aspects today. Principal advised the volunteers to think efficiently for the Society to make positive changes and to make improvement. All the volunteers happily took part in the in the tree plantation. In the afternoon session, an awareness programme about the personal hygiene was conducted by our Chief Guest Dr. R. Menaka MBBS. This session emphasize on the demonstration of the importance of maintaining good personal hygiene and the importance of comprehensive cleaning to maintain a good health and a better personality in the society. Personal hygiene is important for many reasons. Doctor also emphasized that good personal hygiene can reduce a risk of many social, mental, and health problems.





DAY - 3: 24-02-2021 (WEDNESDAY)

Dr. Kamalakannan was the Chief Guest of the forenoon session and delivered lecture on Siddha medicine. Volunteers were excited to make use of the acquired knowledge from the session about Siddha medicine in their daily life to maintain a better social, mental, and physical health. Participants were also happy to share the basic information about personal hygiene. This session was helpful to the volunteers to enhance good habits and make them a better citizen in the society.





Mr. D. Sathish Kumar, Microbiologist was conducted Hb estimation for the volunteers. He delivered a lecture on importance of Hb, how to increase Hb and so on. He also emphasized Hemoglobin is a protein in one's red blood cells that carries oxygen to one's body's organs and tissues and transports carbon dioxide from one's organs and tissues back to one's lungs. He also explained about anemia (low red blood cell count) that one's hemoglobin level is lower than normal.





DAY - 4: 25-02-2021 (THURSDAY)

The volunteers conducted cleaning programmes, plastic waste collection and other awareness campaigns. The NSS volunteers conducted a Temple cleaning under the guidance of NSS Programme officers at Iyyanar Temple at Nallur. Dr. R. Vishalakshi, NSS Coordinator (Colleges) was the Chief Guest and has given the Inaugural Address. All the NSS Volunteers were engaged in the cleaning Programme. The NSS Programme officers divided the NSS Volunteers into several groups. Each group members were allocated with a particular area for cleaning.

RED RIBBON CLUB

REPORT FOR THE YEAR 2020-2021

Red Ribbon Club is a movement started by the Government of India in Educational Institutions through which students will be making awareness of AIDS. The Club imparts information on HIV / AIDS Prevention, Care and Support and Treatment. It also aims in building their capacities as peer educators in spreading messages on positive health behavior in an enabling environment and increasing voluntary blood donation from among youth. It is a platform where skill and knowledge building session are conducted for the student population.

The objectives of the Red Ribbon Club include:

- To spread awareness among the youth particularly the students about the dreaded disease the HIV/AIDS.
- To reduce new occurrences of HIV infection among youth by raising their risk perception through awareness on HIV prevention methods.
- To motivate youth and build their capacity as peer educators and change agents by developing their skills on leadership, negotiation, and team building.
- To promote voluntary blood donation among youth.

The Red Ribbon Club every year initiates an AIDS awareness campaign to celebrate the National Youth Day and mark world AIDS day.

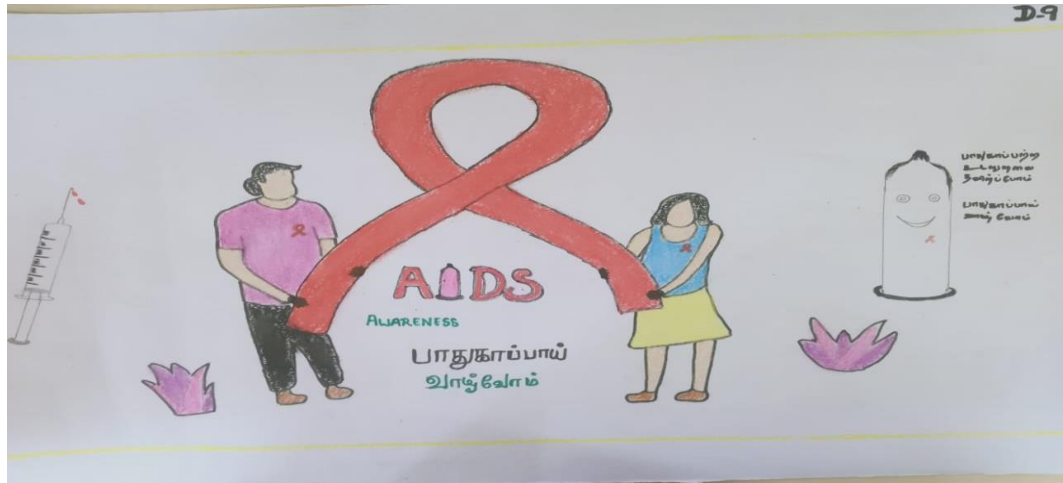


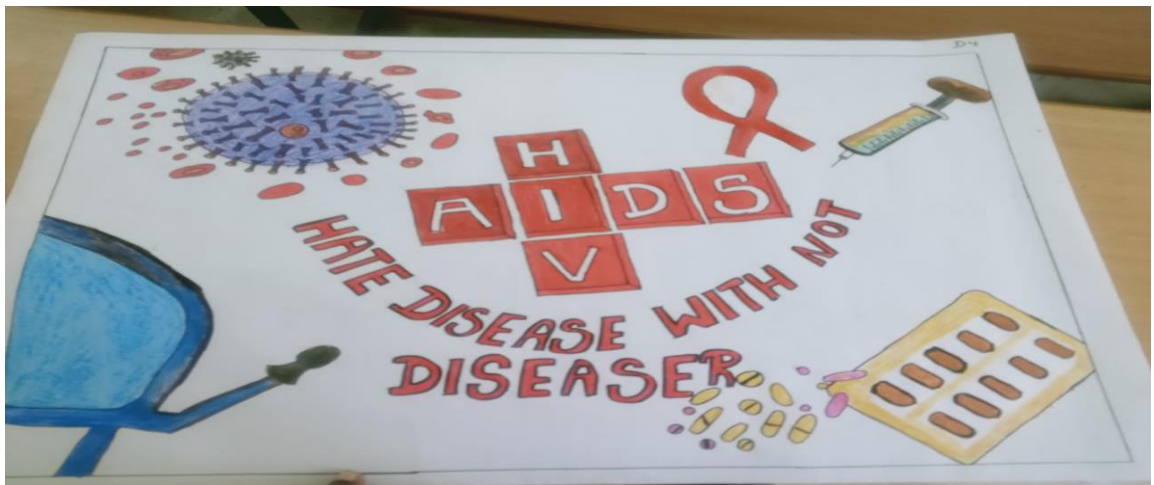
